### Col Mary Feik Cadet Flight Scholarship

Special Eligibility Requirements

1. Must be a current CAP cadet.
  2. Must have earned the Wright Brothers Award (Does not require the Billy Mitchell Award).
  3. Must be at least 15 years old by 1 June 2015. (Does not require 16, like other flight scholarships).
  4. You will be required to obtain a Third Class Medical Certificate to receive a flight scholarship, however, you are not required to have one at the time that you apply.
  5. Cadets will fill out a [questionnaire \(Word Doc\)](#), ([PDF version](#)) rather than a submitting a Resume.
- This scholarship can be used for local flight training at an FBO, training on CAP aircraft with a CAP instructor or at a flight academy.

### Spatz Association – Aerospace Leadership Scholarships

The Spatz Association annually sponsors scholarships to help CAP cadets advance their flight training from solo to private pilot. A limited amount of the scholarship may also be used to attend a CAP leadership activity.

Special Eligibility Requirements

1. Be a current CAP cadet who has earned the Mitchell Award;
2. Have earned solo wings in a powered aircraft;
3. Maintain a 3.0 GPA (normalized);
4. Have not been selected for a similar scholarship or grant.

## FLIGHT SCHOLARSHIPS

### Special Eligibility Requirements for Flight Scholarships

1. Must be at least 16 years old by 1 June 2015 (except for the Col Mary Feik Flight Scholarship, which requires 15 by 1 June 2015).
2. You will be required to obtain a [Third Class Medical Certificate](#) to receive a flight scholarship. However, you are not required to have one at the time that you apply.
3. Be a current CAP member;
4. Have earned the Billy Mitchell Award or received a Senior Rating in any specialty track (**except for the Col Mary Feik Flight Scholarship, which requires only the Wright Brothers Award**);
5. Possess and maintain an academic and discipline standard acceptable to the school;
6. Be enrolled in a full-time course of study during the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded;
7. Have not received the scholarship in the past that you are applying for.

### HOW TO APPLY

1. Log on to e-Services.
2. Select the Scholarships application from the CAP Utilities on the left side. (Only available 1 December through 15 January.)
3. Fill out each of the first three sections.
4. Upload your Resume, Letter of Recommendation (LoR) and Flight plan (if needed). Each document must in PDF, DOC or DOCX format.
5. Go to the fifth section and submit the application.
